Regulation of the work of the Board of Senate

First: Composition of the Board:

A Board called the Board of Senate shall be established and shall be constituted as follows:

1	Vice Chancellor of the University	President
2	Deputy of the vice chancellor(if any) 2	Member
3	Deputy of the University	Member
4	faculty Deans	Members
	Faculty members who are in the professorship degree	Members
6	Departments' heads	Members
7	general director of administration	Member
8	five persons Member of scientific competence from outside the institution chosen by the vice chancellor	Member
9	Secretary of Scientific Affairs	Member and Rapporteur
10	The directors of the research centers and the director of the publishing house	Members

Duties of the Board of Senate

second:

(1) The Board of Senate should have the following powers and authorities:

a-Granting scientific ratification.

b- Recommending to the Committee to approve new programs and curricula after approval by the university council.

c-. Ratification of test results.

d- Nomination of three External Examiners with PhD or equivalent for each program, and submitting their names along with their resume to appoint one of them.

E-Issuing scientific regulations.

F-Proposing the conditions of admission for each specialization to be approved by the Committee.

g-. Upgrade the faculty members after reviewing the recommendation of the promotions committee at the university.

h- Recommendation to the university council to establish the infrastructure for the study programs.

I-Encouraging research, writing and publishing.

J-Inviting the external evaluators to attend the meetings of the faculty to discuss their scientific reports.

Council meetings

Third:

(1) The Board of Senate meets at least three times a year,

in the times and places determined by its head and shall have the right to call for any emergency meeting.

(2) The h head of the Board of Senate, may invite any person to attend any meeting ,without that person having the right to vote.

(3) The quorum of the meetings of the Board of Senate should attended by more than half of the members. Decisions shall be taken by a majority of the members present. In the case of equality, the Chairperson of the Council shall have a weighted vote

(4) at each meeting; the member of the Board of Senate should be given an appropriate financial incentive to be determined by the Executive Committee.
